**Minutes from July 1 : Motion passed** to approve (Marvin/Bruce)

**Giles Run Trash Dump Resolution: Motion passed** to send letter asking Fairfax County to take appropriate action to address the problem; Dick will draft. (Marvin/Sergio)

**Fort Belvoir Resource Advisory Board:** Dick will check on status, say MNCA is interested in participating if such a board is established.

**Cub Scouts:** Adam provided update, said six of the eight current leaders were Eagle Scouts themselves. Reported that the decision of the Boy Scouts' to accept gay leaders has caused some division within the group. A parents meeting was held, and there is a strong desire to keep the scouts going, but options ranging from no change to seeking a new church-based sponsor to disbanding have been proposed but no decision yet.

**Traffic safety problem at Rt. 1/Furnace Road intersection:** There is not sufficient space for large northbound trucks to turn right onto Furnace Road, and recently a truck making the turn struck and badly damaged the car of a Mason Neck resident (but fortunately no injuries). The incident has been reported to VDOT and Mr. Barry Harrison from VDOT is looking into the situation. **Motion passed** to send a letter to VDOT, Supervisors chairperson Bulova, and Supervisor Gerry Hyland, with a copy to Mr. Harrison, saying that something needs to be done,
